

HOMETOWN YIELD CHALLENGE





echelon

In this challenge, growers will compete for an opportunity to give a \$20,000 investment to their project/charity of choice. Two winners will be selected based on the highest yields recorded in each area. Additionally, three runner-ups will be named with an opportunity to give a \$5,000 investment.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- To enter the program, the submission must have:
 - » Field boundary mapped in Echelon
 - » Proven Seed canola hybrid of grower's choice
 - » Phosphorous fertilizer (MAP, MAP+MST) treated with Atlas XC
 - » Use of nutritional products such as Awaken or Radiate encouraged

- Additional Details:
 - » Yield will be calculated on minimum 80 acres, one hybrid per field. The representative check must be located in the same field
 - » Encouraged to post minimum 3 social media posts of the field provided by the staff or farmer
 - Tag the divisional account for your area or send to the division account to post
 - Use #NutrienHometownPride
 - » The highest % growth over grower standard practice (check) from each division will determine the winner

END RESULT

- Two Investments of \$20,000 each (1 for the Black/Irrigated Soil Zone and 1 for the Brown/DarkBrown Soil Zone) will be awarded to the cause of the growers' with highest yields recorded ineach area
- Three additional investments of \$5,000 will be awarded to runners-up in other three divisions
